FACT SHEET AND RULES FOR THE  
2019-2020 ALABAMA SOCIETY DAR SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

1. ASDAR will award two \$1500 scholarships in March 2020.
2. All applicants must be Alabama residents. Only seniors graduating from an accredited high school or home school program are eligible. Applicants must plan to attend an accredited college or university in the State of Alabama, or if the chosen course of study is not offered within the State of Alabama, plan to attend an out-of-state college or university under the Common Market Proviso.
3. Applicant must be a U.S. citizen and provide proof of citizenship as described on the Checklist and Application form.
4. Applications for ASDAR Scholarships must be sent directly to the ASDAR Scholarship Committee Chair. All required forms, recommendations, and other information listed on the application form must be **submitted in one package**. Application packages must be **received** by the ASDAR Scholarship Committee Chair by **January 15, 2020**. Only applications completed correctly, submitted in one package, and received by the deadline will be considered. Late, incomplete, or otherwise incorrect applications will be discarded. Nothing will be returned.
5. Applications will be judged on the basis of academic merit, character, work habits, potential, school-related and community activities, and financial need. Scholarships are judged and awarded without regard to gender, race, color, religion, national origin, or disability. **Personal photographs will result in disqualification and should not be submitted on any page.**
6. Student photographs on transcripts must be covered, blacked-out, or otherwise obscured. **Applications received containing transcripts with un-obscured student photographs will be disqualified.**
7. In order to ensure equitable assessment of an applicant's financial need, the financial need form must contain sufficient information to illustrate the applicant's need for financial assistance. Lack of sufficient information about the applicant's family financial situation may negatively impact consideration of the application.
8. Funds awarded shall be used for educational purposes only and not for personal expense.
9. No relationship with a DAR member is necessary to qualify for an ASDAR scholarship. DAR Chapter sponsorship is not required.
10. Only applications for Alabama Society DAR Scholarships should be sent to the ASDAR Scholarship Committee Chair. **All applications for National Society DAR Scholarships must be submitted on NSDAR forms to the NSDAR Scholarship Chair in accordance with the directions on those forms.**
11. Only the applicants selected, as the recipient of each scholarship, will be notified by March 1, 2020.
